



THE BLACK STUMP at Taree



A Touring Road Event to be conducted by *the HISTORIC RALLY CLUB of NSW-ACT* from Thursday 19th to Saturday 21st October 2017.

The Historic Rally Association and Classic Rally Club as well as the newly formed Endurance Rally Club of Australia will be joining us as an invited clubs for this event. This should give us the opportunity for some good competition.

The Black Stump TRE will comprise two separate events.

Road-Runner will have all the Closed Road Sections, Khanacross and other Autotests and the **Barry Ferguson Classic #2** will be for serious navigation (both Masters and Apprentices).

Competitors will be able to compete in **one event or the other or both** for the same overall cost but you will need to nominate what you wish to run in when you complete the Entry Form.

The Road Runner is for those who wish to have a good spirited drive with an absolute minimum of navigation, (if you remember the cartoon character Road Runner then that is it. No mucking about and lets go get'um) mainly route charts with a few place names tossed to get you there easily.



We will be doing registration and a prologue at the Westlake Khanacross track at Awaba on the Central Coast and overnighting at Taree We will be going out each day for Closed Road Sections, khanacross and navigation tests.

We will base the HQ in Taree at the Dawson River Caravan Park for the entire event and will have a presentation dinner in the Taree area on the Saturday evening

We will be running the maximum number of Closed Road Sections that CAMS permit each day (2). If they approve changes being currently considered to the regulations for this style of event in time for this event then we may be able to fit a few more in as well.

By starting before lunch on Thursday and reducing our travel distances each day we will get almost 50% extra over the first of our events earlier this year (Southern Mountains Trial Revisited) and be able keep the entry fee the same as that event (\$600).

The Supplementary Regs and Entry Form accompany this Introduction whether on websites or by mailing lists.

As a guide for prospective competitors in the Road Runner.

There will be route charts for all Closed Road Sections and, diagrams and arrows for the Khanacross tests and reference to place names on the official maps and route charts on the combined Road Touring Sections.

The liaison sections for the Road Runners that will be conducted while the navigation tests for the BFC are being conducted, will be route charted throughout.

Any navigation past that level is reserved only for those doing the BFCs navigation tests.

You may enter for both events if you wish but the navigation tests are NOT part of the Road Runner awards.

There will be a more detailed "***Guide to the Black Stump at Taree***" issued prior to the event that will cover other aspects of the event.
