#### Scrutiny

Official Scrutiny is at **Alex's Automotive 11 Silver St Eltham 3095 (Mel 21 H5) (03) 9439 9530** on Wednesday 2 October from 6:00pm until 9:00pm. Last check-in at 8:30 pm.

Crews should report to the Entries Secretary in the office for documentation and to receive their scrutiny queue order. A reminder that event paperwork including Route Instructions, Service Instructions and numbers supplied by the organiser will be issued at event Book-in in Strath Creek.

There will be no scrutiny at the start of the event.

#### Rally Headquarters

Rally Headquarters will be located at the Strath Creek Hall. This will also be the location for the following:

- Communications Centre,
- The Official Notice board
- Scoring (note: scoring will also be available at the halfway service)
- Rally HQ Telephone

## Book-in Time & Location

Saturday book-in takes place at Rally Headquarters at the Strath Creek Hall between 1500 hrs and 1630 hrs.

Your Service Crew will need to book-in and sign the Disclaimer if they want CAMS insurance cover. If your service crew has a mobile phone, please ensure the Event Secretary is given that contact number when booking in. This will enable the organisers to contact your service crew quickly should you require assistance.

## Crew Briefing

The Crew Briefing will take place at 1815 hrs on the day of the event near the start location at Strath Creek Hall

## Service Location & Fuel Supplies

The Service Park for the event is No.1 Camp at the intersection of Flowerdale and Allison's Rds in Mt Disappointment State Forest

- Car trailers can be left at the Strath Creek Hall [Rally Finish] or there is limited space for trailers near the service location.
- Service vehicles only are to be taken into the Service area – no cars from 'family & friends'.
- The nearest pump fuel is at Strath Creek. Unleaded (91 RON) and Premium Unleaded (95 RON) fuel is available. However this will close at 7pm. The next nearest is on the Hume Freeway near Wallan.
- There will be a remote refuel point near the service park.

## Fuel Range

Crews are alerted to the following distances between service, and the range thus required:

Start – Service: Competitive: **45.06** km. Transport: **36.39** km Total: **81.45** km

Service – Finish: Competitive: **45.00** km Transport: **35.21** km Total: **80.21** km

## Controls & Timing

All Sections will be run under A to B timing for both competitiveness and transports. Timing and scoring will be to the second. Time taken on competitiveness will accrue as penalties up to the maximum time nominated for that Stage and thereafter as late time. (**Clarification of item 13.1 in Supplementary Regulations**).

Time taken on transports in excess of the time allowed will accrue as late time.

Penalties will be applied in accordance with Clause 5.2 of the National Rally Code and the Victorian Rally Bulletin.

Missing major controls will be permitted, however crews should note it will be necessary to complete 75% of the competitive distance to be deemed a finisher and to have booked in to every Division End Control.

The Chief Timekeeper / Scorer is deemed to be a Judge of Fact in all timing matters.

## Odometer Check

The Road Directors odometer read 5.00 between the 3 km and 8 km posts on the Strath Creek-Flowerdale Road. These will be marked with ODO START and ODO FINISH boards on the day of the event.

## Catering

Catering is available at the start at Strath Creek General Store.

There will be a BBQ at the Service Park run by the Strath Creek CFA so please support this as the CFA are doing a lot to support this event.

There will also be a spit roast available at the finish at Strath Creek Hall.
