



Motorkhana Come & Try—15 November 2014

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Message from the Clerk of Course

Welcome and thank-you for your interest in the PAC Come & Try Motorkhana. The Event is designed to give participants a basic understanding of motorsport and the opportunity to drive some typical motorkhana tests under the guidance of experienced competitors. It is run as a closed-to-club come-and-try motorkhana at the McGregor Road grounds of the Pakenham Auto Club. In order to be covered by CAMS insurance, the event is open only to members of PAC who hold a CAMS competition licence. To achieve this, PAC will make each non-member a temporary member for the duration of the event; and cover the \$20 cost of a [CAMS L2NSJ licence](#) for under-18s. Click on the link above or type

<http://docs.cams.com.au/CAMS%20Forms/Competitors/CAMS%20Level%20%20Licence.pdf> into your browser to download the relevant application form. Forms will be available on the day, but it can save time if they are filled in and brought to the venue.

The event is aimed at juniors (at least 12 and less than 18 years of age). A maximum of twenty (20) participants will be accepted. Juniors do not need to supply their own car as the PAC Junior Motorsport Club Cars will be at their disposal; both manual and automatic cars will be available. All cars will be checked for safety by club scrutineers before being allowed to participate.

PAC is not a child minding group; Juniors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian who remains at the venue throughout the day. Parents and guardians are encouraged to attend the Participant Briefing as this will give them a good insight into what to expect if the child proceeds further into a motorsporting career.

The day will be very casual, but will follow proper motorsport procedure.

After signing on, we will start with a Participant Briefing – a classroom session that gives a brief overview and history of the Pakenham Auto Club, provides some fundamental motorsport safety information and describes the various different types of motorsport from the basic club motorkhana up to the World Formula 1 Grand Prix Championship.

Next, we will move to the practical session. Participants will be split into small groups, each assigned a Group Leader and an Instructor/Demonstrator. Motorsport is dangerous, so Participants are required to respond immediately to any instruction from a Group Leader or Instructor/Demonstrator. A Participant failing to do so may be excluded from the premises.

This is a come-and-try fun day. There will be no timing. There will be no scoring. There will be no event awards.

I would like to acknowledge and thank all the people and organisations that have contributed to making the come and try event possible including Pakenham Auto Club, CAMS, the Motorkhana panel, and the PAC members who have given up their time to make the event happen.

Bring the family, bring the friends – we look forward to seeing you there.

Entries: Must be made on the attached entry form, and sent to the Clerk of Course before the time that Entries Close.

Entry Limit: 20 accepted in order of receipt of fully completed entry form. Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83.

Catering / Facilities: Toilets will be available at the venue; please bring a bottle of water to maintain hydration.

Anti-Doping Policy: During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A and 145B of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing, the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s). **Other Prohibited Substances:** the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and as amended from time to time, recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy will apply. Additionally, in any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy conflict, the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy will apply.

Force Majeure: The event *may* be postponed if there is extreme weather in the area either on or prior to the day of competition. Phone 0410148058 before 10am on Saturday 15 November 2014, if in doubt. Abandonment, postponement and cancellation will be in accordance with NCR 59.
